The Bartender will contribute to our continued success by demonstrating unsurpassed guest service, a high level of integrity and ethical standards, and personal, and professional dedication to our Mission, Vision, and Values.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Prepare and serve alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks in accordance with standard recipes for patrons
- Providing a positive and friendly guest experience by interacting with patrons
- Assess customers' needs and preferences and make recommendations
- Upsell drink and snack items to customers
- Ensure that no one under the age of 21 may purchase or consume any alcoholic beverages by checking IDs of all patrons in accordance with state law.
- Restock and replenish bar inventory and supplies
- Comply with all ABC regulations
- Upsell drink and snack items to customers
- Help to ensure that all alcoholic beverages remain on premises and do not leave the building with any individual in accordance with State Law and The Z's Liquor License.
- Able to provide information to the patron about The Z and Town Center areas
- Work positively with other Box Office staff, Concession Staff, Tech Staff, and Artists and their team and communicate thoroughly with each other.
- Procure IPAD and cash for the concessions register. Responsible for setting up Ipad and Square account for point of sales and for counting and closing out the cash at the end of shift.
- Setup for the designated Concessions Stand (Mainstage of Studio Theater), Set up all concessions supplies in designated area in a timely manner
- Restocking Concessions inventory as needed
- Lifting of boxes of wine or beer, lifting and changing out kegs during shift
- Maintaining a clean, safe work space in concessions
- Communicating with House Management when supplies are low in our concessions closet

- Responsible for end of event cleaning and inventory before leaving, including returning all drinks, snacks, cups, tools, and misc. to their beginning locations and taking trash to the dumpster
- Clean, sweep, vacuum, mop, disinfect, etc.
- Have thorough knowledge of Theater evacuation procedures and be prepared to take assist with evacuation in the event of an emergency.
- Assists with orienting new employees to their work area.
- Follow all Concessions policies and procedures.
- Complete ABC online training and E-Tips training
- Execute other duties as assigned by the management

Requirements and Qualifications

- Experience in a bar or similar environment
- 21 years of age and over
- Must be able to lift up 20-pound and stand for long periods of time
- Strong knowledge of spirits, wine, champagne, and mixed cocktails
- Must be people-oriented, provide outstanding customer service
- Be enthusiastic and pleasant while interacting with customers
- Maintain a clean, well-stocked, and safe working environment
- Pay attention to detail and ability to follow proper procedure and protocols
- Knowledge of applicable ABC laws and regulations
- Impeccable customer service and social perceptiveness
- Professional and clean appearance during work hours
- Ability to enforce company policies regarding the consumption of alcohol
- Accountability in maintaining inventory and processing payments
- Familiar with Point-of-Sale transactions and comfortable with Technology on an Ipad
- Interest in not-for-profit, theater and/or entertainment industries
- Familiar with The Z's website along with current and upcoming performances.
